WELLNESS POLICY  
\*UPDATED 6/26/20\*

In all of our Fairview Kid's areas, our cleaning crew & volunteers sterilize all surfaces used by our children. This includes cleaning twice a week and cleaning classrooms. We recommend using the sanitizing stations at the desk as well.

In an effort to keep Fairview Kids free from spreadable illnesses, we will continue to follow our standard health protocols and we ask for your understanding if we feel we cannot accept your kids into our programs due to health concerns.

### **Allergies**

If your child has a continually clear runny nose or rash due to non-contagious allergies, please let us know.

### **Coughing**

We understand that coughing can be the result of many different things. If your child has a persistent cough (along with any other symptom), we ask that you keep your child home until the cough and/or other symptoms are diagnosed by a professional and proper action has taken place.

### **Diarrhea or Vomiting**

A child must be symptom-free for 24 hours before attending any Fairview Kid's events or activities.

### **Fever or Elevated Temperature**

Fairview Kids will not admit any child with an elevated temperature (above 99.6 F).

*A child must be fever-free for 24 hours before attending any Fairview Kid's events or activities.*

### **Eye Infections (Pink Eye, etc.)**

Please keep your child home if they have crusty, red, and/or discharge from their eye(s). Please consult your pediatrician to determine when the eye infection is no longer contagious. Please wait at least 24 hours after the medicine has been given.

### **Lice**

Please keep your child home if they have active lice. In the event that it is found during Fairview Kid's hours, we will notify the child's parents immediately and then

the rest of the classroom's parents. Specialized deep clean will follow in the classroom.

### **Chickenpox**

Please keep your child home if they have chickenpox. Please wait until it has fully run its course and the child is Chickenpox free!

### **Measles & Mumps**

Please keep your child home if they have been diagnosed with Measles or Mumps. Please wait until it has fully run its course and proper treatment has been given.

### **Rashes**

A child must be rash free or be accompanied by a doctor's note explaining that the newly developed rash is not contagious.

### **Runny Nose**

If your child has colored discharge from their nose, we ask that you keep them home.

### **Strep Throat**

If your child has strep throat, we ask that you keep them home until 24 hours after treatment has started and they are able to participate in regular activities.

### **NOTE**

Please use your discernment on whether or not you should bring your child to Fairview Kid's for any illness outside of those listed here. We understand that germs are a part of life and that kids tend to share those generously, but we want to do our best to mitigate any widespread illnesses as possible.
